Financial Update

It has been many weeks since we provided an update on the finances. Many thanks to everyone who responded to that message!

As you can see from the table below, as of the end of May we met and surpassed our budget target for undesignated offerings. We have also had reduced expenses because some projects are on hold, and we have received some stipend, housing, allotment, and salary relief from the Diocese. As of the end of May, we have a healthy surplus.

We are doing quite well, but the next few months will be challenging.

It is June and the Parish is once again responsible for allotment and the Rector's stipend and housing costs. We must make up for loss of rental income. The videos filmed and uploaded each week are an unbudgeted expense. The annual plant sale and the weekly book sale at coffee hour cannot take place. Offerings are usually lower in the summer. We hope that we will soon be able to worship together in greater numbers, but we still face a lot of uncertainty.

We ask that you help, as best you can, to keep the momentum going.
