



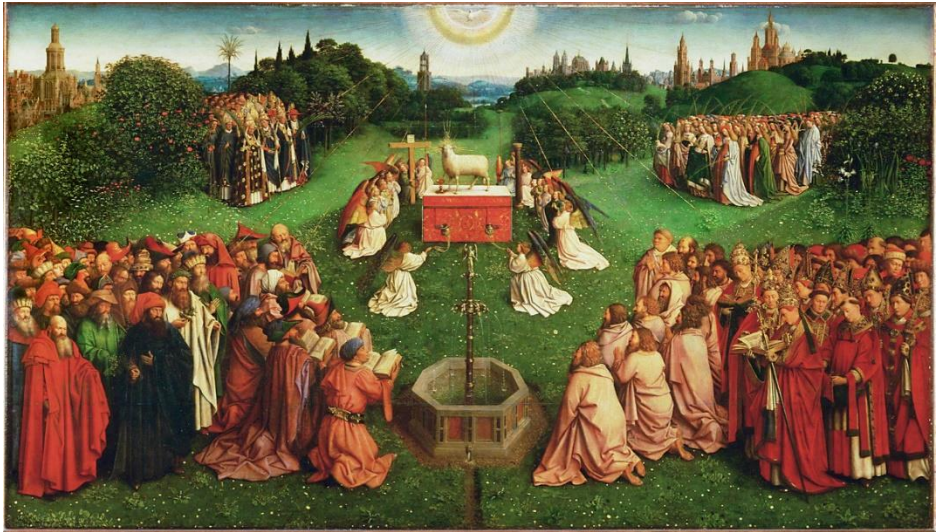

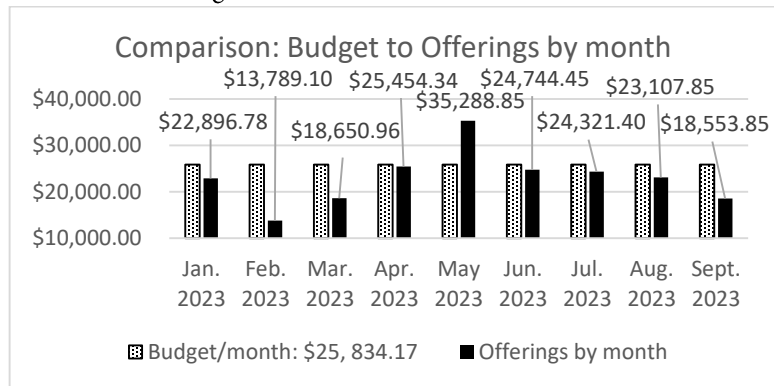

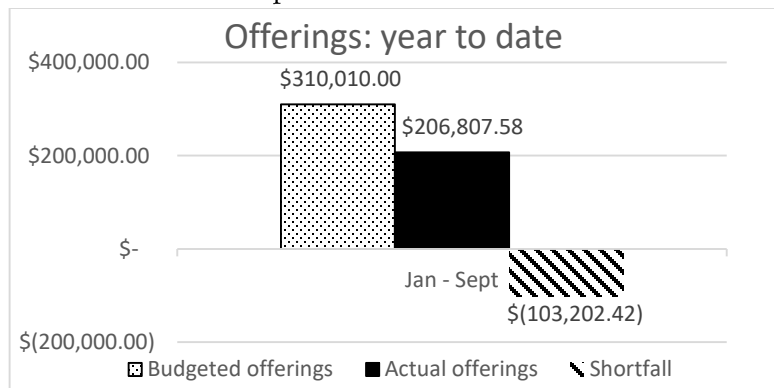

## Financial update for October 2023

Last month I was hopeful that I might be the first parish treasurer in many years not to lead a fall campaign to make the offerings budget. Unfortunately, last month's figures did not include the August payroll for our paid folks, but that has now been rectified. Unfortunately, this means that the overall deficit is much higher than we expected. September was also the second-lowest month of the year for offerings. At the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter we are now significantly behind our budgeted amount for offerings.



In order to break even at the end of the year, we'll need to see offerings increase by about one third over the next three months. We have been in this deficit position many times before and so this challenge is not beyond us! This is our first year of full operation since the COVID pandemic began and what an encouragement it would be to finish financially strong as we seek to renew our parish's ministries.
